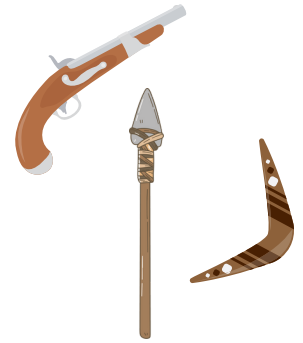

- To give information about past battles

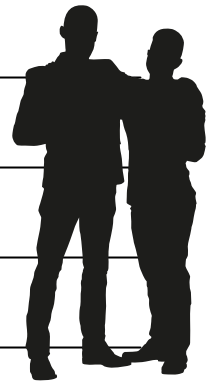


4. Name two countries Australia helped through peacekeeping missions.

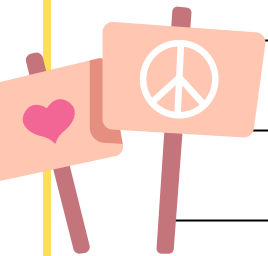
 5. Why might alliances such as ANZUS be beneficial? Could there be any drawbacks to such alliances?
